



## **MWBA CODE OF CONDUCT FOR LOCAL COMPETITION**

**Awareness & Compliance with MWBA's Local Competition Code of Conduct is a condition of entry into the NBISC stadium.**

The following policies and procedures will be in effect at any MWBA Local Competition game. If any of these policies are breached a designated official appointed by the MWBA will ask the person responsible to leave the premises.

1. There will be a Zero Tolerance Policy (in accordance to the BNSW Zero Tolerance Policy) towards any abusive or inappropriate behaviour from players, spectators and team officials towards game referees, players, score bench personnel or members of the public.
2. Any player, team official, coach, manager, or spectator who feels the necessity to
  - A. Persistently or willfully question or challenge the rulings of the referees
  - B. Berate or abuse referees or other participants
  - C. Ridicule, or utter obscenities
  - D. Display conduct which is inappropriate in a sporting environment.

will not only be asked to leave the stadium, but may also be penalised and/or be required to appear before the MWBA Judiciary, where additional penalties such as suspensions may be applied.

Players and team officials who would like to offer feedback or request clarification on officiating issues should either speak to a Referee, Referee Supervisor or Court Supervisor at an appropriate time.
