CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

As of January 2021

BY ENTERING ANY VENUE UNDER THE CONTROL OR DIRECTION OF MANLY WARRINGAH BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION DURING THE OPERATION OF MWBA COMPETITIONS OR PROGRAMS, YOU ARE AGREEING TO:

- Abide by the MWBA Codes of Conduct, Zero Tolerance Policy, Competition by Laws and adhere to the requirements of the MWBA Covid-19 Safety Plan.
- Register your personal details using the QR Code provided to meet the requirement of the MWBA Covid-19 Safety Plan.
- Adequately supervise any minors in your care.
- Obey any reasonable direction from an MWBA official or staff member.
- The use of your image for promotional purposes (images will not contain information to identify individuals).
- Refrain from bringing basketballs, animals, glass, weapons or any other item likely to cause inconvenience to staff or other patrons in the venue.
- Refrain from smoking, consuming alcohol or drugs on the premises, or being intoxicated whilst on the premises.

These guidelines have been developed in order to maintain patron and staff safety. While staff are expected to enforce the Conditions of Entry at all times, discretion may be required in certain circumstances.

To minimise the risk of contracting or transmitting COVID-19, at all times:

- Do not attend the venue if you are feeling unwell and experiencing symptoms such as a cough, sore throat, fever, cold or 'flu-like symptoms, fatigue or shortness of breath;
- Do not attend the venue if, in the last 14 days, you have been unwell or had close contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19;
- Do not attend the venue if you have attended any of the current NSW COVID-19 Case locations.

Please remember that we all perceive levels of risk about infection differently. We must respect each other's views and work collaboratively to find a reasonable compromise where safety, hygiene and risk is managed within Government regulations.
