## 2022 SEMESTER ONE SENIOR COMPETITION INFORMATION SHEET

Welcome to the M.W.B.A. Semester One Competition which will run from 31<sup>st</sup> January to 29<sup>th</sup> June 2022. We hope this information sheet will answer any queries you may have. Please do not hesitate to call the office if anything is unclear.

### Entries:

Entries for competition are done online through the Members Area of our website (top right corner). The Manager must have a Membership and must be 18 years or old. Teams must have a minimum of 7 players to enter the team. Managers should have the players name, DOB and emails ready to make the registration process easier. Team entries will close Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 **unless sold out prior**. A deposit of \$250 will be taken to secure the teams spot in the competition. The deposit is not refundable and will be deducted from your competition fees.

### Officials:

Referee Courses are being run regularly, MWBA is always looking for more referees. Each team is required to provide two people to do duty when their team is rostered on. Failure to do duty will result in a \$60 fee to cover the cost of getting replacements. Continued failure will result in the team being illuminated from the competition.

## Registrations:

**All players must be registered or affiliated with the MWBA, Registration includes BasketballAustralia Insurance.**

- Senior - \$120 for 12 months.

Non Registered players will NOT be permitted to take the court after 2 weeks of play. Any team that plays an unregistered player will lose the points for the game played. Registration is completed online in the Members Area on the top right corner of the website.

**Affiliations** This fee of \$50 is paid only by players who are registered at a basketball association other than the MWBA. *Affiliations must be done by calling the office on 9913 3622 extension 2.*

## Cour Fees:

Please refer to the competition schedule table for court fees.

## An invoice will be forwarded to the Manager.

The team has 14 days to pay the balance of their fees. Fees are paid online through the Membership Area of the website, located in the top right corner. Players access their membership account and once logged into their dashboard they will be able to make payment. Teams that are not financial will not be able to play.

## Forfeits:

Teams are allowed one forfeit if notification to MWBA office is before 9am on game day. If a team forfeits more than once or after 9am on game day, a forfeit fee of \$50 will be charged for every forfeit made thereafter. Payment must be made before next scheduled game.

MWBA reserves the right to refuse playing time to teams that have not paid court fees as above.

## Withdrawals:

Teams withdrawing from competitions after the draw has been produced will forfeit their deposit. Players from un-financial teams will be required to pay their portion of any moneys owed to MWBA by the team before they play for any other team.

## Scoresheet:

Players must be preprinted on a scoresheet. If a name is not on the scoresheet, then the player must be cleared by the court supervisor to be able to play. Any change to the team roster should be emailed to [maria.panetta@manlybasketball.com.au](mailto:maria.panetta@manlybasketball.com.au) prior to 2pm on the day of the game.

## Team Uniform:

- All teams must have a proper set of identical singlets that are reversible.
- Uniforms must be properly numbered (preferably 4-15 but NBA numbers are acceptable) on the front and back of all uniforms. Taped or hand written numbers are not acceptable.
- No inappropriate names should be on the back of singlets. Players will be removed from the game if their singlet is deemed inappropriate.
- All members of a team must wear the same colored shorts (pockets are not permitted).

## Other:

- **NO RUDENESS TOWARDS REFEREES OR CONSTANT QUESTIONING OF CALLS WILL BE TOLERATED.**  
Court Supervisors or Referees may cite constant offenders to appear before a disciplinary tribunal, and these offenders may suffer lengthy suspensions.

- MWBA reserves the right to place a team in the appropriate level of competition.
- When games are cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, the Local comp committee will determine what is best for the competition as regards to points. No refunds will be issue for the gamenot played.
- In order to be eligible to play in the Semi Finals and Grand Finals, a player must have played in 50% of all scheduled games in the competition or 75% of the games in the second half of the competition. Managers can track how many games a player has played by logging into their Members dashboard through the Members Area of the website.
