

# What's Involved In Rep 2022

**MWBA** is an Association that offers the opportunity for players to represent the Manly Warringah area in the NSW Junior Leagues from U/12 to U/18 age groups at Junior level and then to progress to Senior Representative level - Youth League (U/23's) and NBL1.

Manly Rep team's play against Associations located in the Greater Sydney Metropolitan area. The games will be played equally between the home & the away associations.

Preseason will usually commence mid-March, & the official season/games commence around April. Grand Finals are usually scheduled at the end of July or the start of August. Dates can differ slightly from year to year. Games are played on Sundays anywhere between 9am and 4pm. Generally, no games are scheduled during the middle weekend of the school holidays, however, please check the BNSW draw before scheduling holidays. You can expect to make 5/6 trips to the wider metropolitan area of Sydney.

## Fees

2022 fees are \$600. Squad selections will be posted on the website the Wednesday after trials. Once teams are selected, players will immediately be invoiced for \$300 deposit (non-refundable) to confirm their place in the program. The remaining \$300 will be due prior to the commencement of the Rep season in April, you will be invoiced accordingly.

## Games and Training

A game can take up to 60 to 80 minutes to complete, depending on the age group. Under 12's & Under 14's play 8 minute fully timed quarters. U16's & Under 18's play 10 minute fully timed quarters. Players are required to arrive around 45 minutes before the scheduled game commences. The team manager & coach will be able to provide more details. Teams typically train twice a week. Venue & time will be determined based on coach & venue availability. There are also many opportunities for players to be involved in Basketball NSW programs.

## Teams

Teams consist of 10 players. Each team will have players of varying ability & experience. As this is a Representative Sport, players have to earn their court time by training hard to improve their skill level.

We have excellent qualified coaching staff who are volunteers. MWBA has a coaching program in place with clear guidelines for our coaches. The aim of the Program is to encourage each individual player to improve their skills, & assist each team to achieve its highest possible level.

## Uniforms & Other sports

The Association provides the numbered playing singlet; however, each player is required to purchase shorts (\$45) & Warm up Top (\$45), and a double-sided training singlet \$45. Days and times for purchasing MWBA sporting apparel will be advised.

Representative Basketball is played on a Sunday, & will conflict with other sports that are also played on Sundays. Please note that for Preseason games, JPL games & State Championships, players may be required to play on a Saturday.
