

REP AGREEMENT & INFO FORM 2024

Dear Parents

Please read this document carefully, as it contains important information

Congratulations on your child's selection in the **MWBA Junior Representative Program**. The fee for this season is **\$700**, split into 2 installments - **\$350** will be invoiced immediately to confirm your place in the squad, & then **\$350** which will be invoiced prior to the season starting.

The estimated cost for each player to play Representative Basketball is \$1000+, however we try to keep our fees as low as possible.

Camps, Fees

- **Representative fee \$700** – split into **2** installments of **\$350** & must be paid by the due date
- **Support Senior teams** - by participating in floor wiping activities at their games at least once a season.
- Most venues charge a **\$4 entry fee**, this fee is set by **BNSW**, & contributes to game costs, this includes NBISC
- **Rep Camps** will run during the school holiday periods, & players are expected to attend.
- **All fees must be paid** prior to the commencement of the season

Compulsory Requirements. There are certain requirements to play in the MWBA Representative Program.

- Attend **all** training and/or skills sessions for their team and **all** competition games
- **Adhere** to the BNSW Codes of Conduct, Representative/Development Player Agreement, & the Zero Tolerance Policy for Parents and Spectators
- **Parents must attend a Score table course run by MWBA & commit to Score table (bench) duties. Time & dates to be advised.**
- **Other Representative sports WILL NOT CONFLICT OR AFFECT Rep Basketball commitments, including both games & training. Failure to comply with this, could result in the player concerned being withdrawn from the program.**
- **Allow MWBA** to use your contact details for Fee invoicing, Newsletters, & also by Coaches & Managers for all team information & communication, including training, game times, venues & contact distribution lists. Also allow MWBA to post your child's name to advertise any Basketball achievement during the Representative season.
- **Please advise if you do not wish this to occur.**

Please note that some teams may choose to enter in external tournaments, such as the Coastal Classic in February, & possibly also a Melbourne tournament over the June Long weekend. Please realise this is a team decision & **NOT** a compulsory expectation of MWBA, however if the team decides to enter, there will be additional costs involved.

Basketball NSW - Codes of Conduct, Representative & Player agreements & the Zero Tolerance Policy for Parents & Spectators - must be read through thoroughly, before signing your acceptance document - They are displayed on our website. <https://manlybasketball.com.au/about/policies/>
