However, for **MWBA venues**, the following procedures will apply:

Manly Warringah Basketball Association, has a number of policy guidelines & procedures in the area of **Child Safety**, which include a **Member Protection Policy**, the adoption of the **BNSW Disciplinary Tribunal By-Laws** & the **BNSW Codes of Conduct**

MWBA will ensure the following **strategies** are in place.

- MWBA staff values, align with the organisation's commitment to child safety.
- Awareness, recognition & intervention strategies are in place.
- All Staff, Coaches & Managers have a current Working with Childrens Check verified by the Childrens Guardian. Details are recorded.
- Player pickups from representative training venues are always supervised by an adult parent/manager.
- Court Supervisors & CCTV cameras are in place in the NBISC 6 court venue.
- Single court external venues will have a court supervisor on site, however all participants at these
 venues, must be accompanied by a responsible adult, such as a parent, teacher or manager to
 supervise children with the usage of external amenities, & assist with evacuation during emergency
 procedures.
- New staff to be screened & MWBA Child Safety values & expectation processes explained.
- MWBA coaches attending school clinics will pass MWBA safety checks, & any further checks
 initiated by the school, prior to entering school premises.
- MWBA recognises there are several forms of harm & abuse, such as Sexual Abuse, Psychological Abuse & physical Abuse, as well as neglect.
- Report processes must be clear & transparent to all parents, staff, coaches & managers.
- MWBA is aware of Criminal offences for not acting to protect children.
- We are a **Child Safety Association**, this will be publicised, via our website & social media sites.
- Strict **Social Media rules** regarding children are in place, adults are not to make contact with any player under the age of 18, nor can they be friends or followers on any social media sites.
